
Thank you for your letter of 5 May providing the submission of the Australian Emergency Care Providers in relation to the Draft Cost Recovery Impact Statement and Draft fees schedule proposed for the Australian Skills Quality Authority.

As you would know, officers of the Taskforce establishing the national VET regulator met with representatives of AECF in Melbourne to further discuss their concerns about these draft documents.

Consultation on the fees has occurred with a range of other stakeholders as well and over 140 submissions were made to the NVR Taskforce during the consultation period. A number of changes have been made to the fees schedule in consideration of this feedback. As is required, a revised fee schedule will now go to the Ministerial Council for its comment before being finalised as a legislative instrument.
